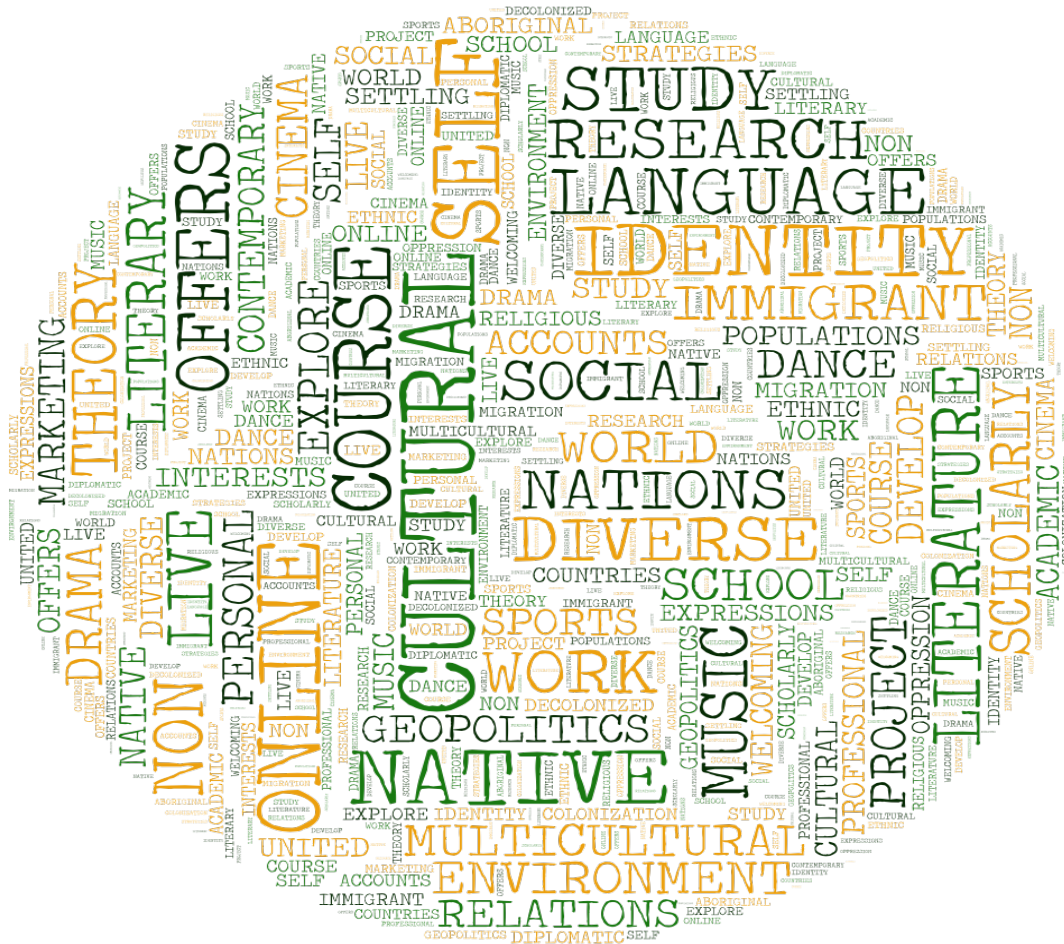


SPRING 2016 - NEW ONLINE COURSE

FL 4100/5100 - LANGUAGE THEORIES AND GLOBAL ISSUES



This online course offers an in-depth study of the fabric of language, its impact on self- and cultural identity, and its roles in the shaping of social relations, school and work environments, and geopolitics. Through the lenses of scholarly research, world literature, literary and cultural theory, and first-hand accounts by immigrant populations, students will reflect on what constitutes cultural identity.

Creating a research project will help undergraduate students explore contemporary expressions of cultural identity through their personal interests (sports, marketing, music, dance, drama, cinema, literature, etc.).

Designing a professional research project will allow graduate students to consider the practical consequences of language and culture in their field of study and develop strategies to live and work in a diverse environment.
